2021 PUBLIC SPEAKING CONTEST

RULES

<u>Deadline: Thursday, February 4, 2021 12:00pm NOON</u> Entry Fee-\$20.00

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The Public Speaking Contest is open to any contestant who is a citizen of the United States, a current resident of Matagorda County or attends home school, private school, or public school for the current year in Matagorda County.
- 2. Contestants will be divided into three categories. The Senior Division will consist of contestant's grades 9-12, the Intermediate Division will consist of contestant's grades 6-8, and the Junior Division will consist of contestant's grade 3-5.
- 3. Previous winners may continue to compete in their same age division for as long as they are eligible by age for that division.

SUBJECT MATTER

- 1. Contestants are free to choose their subject matter if it relates to any agricultural topic, anything that can be connected to agriculture and its way of life, or anything relating to the Fair or subjects that can be found at the Fair.
- 2. Contestants must present speeches composed of original material. If other sources of information are used in preparing the speech, the contestant should give source credit in the speech.
- 3. A contestant MAY NOT repeat a speech used previously in this contest.

TIME LIMIT

- 1. Each speech shall be a minimum of four (4) minutes and a maximum of seven (7) minutes in length. Speeches that are under four (4) minutes or over seven (7) minutes in length will be deducted ten (10) points per minute, with a maximum of twenty (20) points deducted.
- 2. The judging committee will be allowed two (2) minutes to ask questions of the intermediate participants and five (5) minutes to ask questions of the senior participants.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Judges will be selected from out of the county and will have knowledge on judging public speaking.
- 2. Contestants from each division will be drawn prior to contest by public speaking committee for speaking order.
- 3. Contestants will be permitted to use notes, but excessive reference to notes may result in point deductions by the judges.
- 4. No props, or visual aids, music, etc. will be permitted.
- 5. A designated timekeeper will record time used by each contestant, noting under time and overtime.
- 6. Each judge will be allowed to ask questions to Intermediate and Senior Participants which must pertain to the contestant's speech. Each contestant will be judged on his or her ability to answer the questions.
- 7. Buckles will be awarded to the top one (1) Junior, top one (1) Intermediate, and top one (1) Senior Public Speaking contestants.
- 8. You may request a copy of your scorecard. These copies will be available two (2) weeks after the Fair and upon a written request to the Fair Office.
- 9. ENTRY DEADLINE: To Fair Office by 12:00 pm, NOON, on February 5, 2021.
- 10. Contest will be held **Sunday**, <u>February 21, 2021</u> at the Van Vleck Auditorium Contestants should be at the Auditorium by 12:30 pm.
- 11. All protests concerning Matagorda County Fair Entries must be submitted prior to judging and be accompanied by a \$150 cash deposit. The deposit will be returned ONLY if the protest is upheld. Once judging has commenced NO protests will be accepted. The Judges decision is final and not subject for protest. Judging procedures will not be interrupted for protest investigation. The protest will be reviewed by at least (5) members of the Fair Board. The ruling of the Fair Board Directors will be final. Both sides of the protest must be present at the time of the protest. There will be no anonymous protests accepted. Every exhibitor, in consideration of his/her entry being accepted by the Matagorda County Fair and Livestock Association, agrees that the conclusion reached by the Fair Board Directors shall be final, without any recourse against the Matagorda County Fair and Livestock Association, Board of Directors, Division Chairman, Superintendent, or Committeemen.
